## QUICK START

**Step 2:** Register for an account within the New York Times website. All you need is an email address and a password. Make sure to stay logged on to the New York Times Online account to have unlimited access.

**Step 3:** Enjoy the articles, videos and images that NYT Online has to offer. You will be able to access the current edition, plus archives from 1851 through 1922, and 1985 through current day!

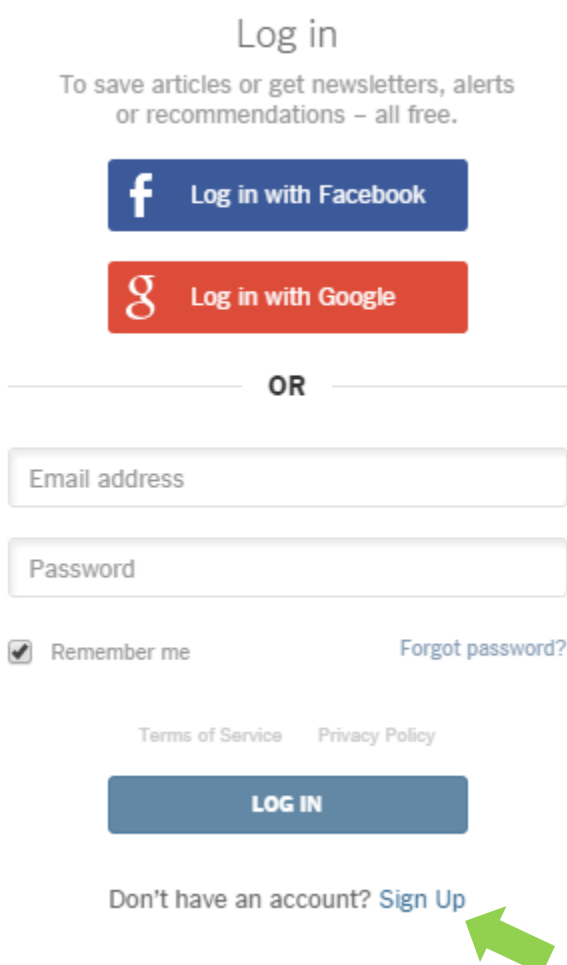
# The New York Times
