

Galveston City Hall and Market - 22nd between Market and Mechanic



This stunning public building was built in 1888, and designed by Alfred Muller. Although it was badly damaged in the 1900 Storm, the building was renovated and continued as the city hall until 1916. It was then converted as a fire and police station. The building was demolished in 1964.
