

Rosenberg Library - 823 Tremont



Named for its benefactor Henry Rosenberg, the Rosenberg Library is descended from the Galveston Mercantile Library, and is the oldest public library in continuous operation in Texas. The building was dedicated in 1904 and was designed by Eames & Young of St. Louis in Italian renaissance revival style. In 1971, it dedicated the Moody wing which nearly doubled the size of the building.
