### Book Summary



She survives the United States' most deadly natural disaster, the Galveston hurricane of 1900, and the demise of the "unsinkable" Titanic. Instead of breaking her, they set her on the path to success and love. World events and a changing culture impact her and her family to weave a story of tragedy, triumph, and self-awakening. ***Winds of Change*** is a mixture of fact and fiction that tells the story of a woman and a nation as they come of age.

Jo Adams McAuley was born in Waco, Texas. She attended the University of Arkansas in Fayetteville and earned a degree in Political Science. After graduation, Jo moved to Washington, D.C. and served for a time on the staff of Senator John McClellan. In 1979, she relocated to the Houston area and worked in sales and event management. Eventually, she became an educator and taught U. S. Government to high school seniors. Since retiring several years ago, she has focused on her writing.
